Noreen Brand is Director of Education for the Illinois Holocaust Museum and Education Center in Skokie, Illinois. She received the Anne Frank Outstanding Educator Award for 2010. Noreen moved to the Chicago area after a 12 year tenure with the Florida Holocaust Museum in St. Petersburg, where she was director of curatorial affairs, responsible for oversight of all exhibitions, education and public programs which included traveling exhibitions, survivor/liberator services, docent training, exhibition training, teacher training workshops, annual summer institutes for teachers as well as the March of the Living and state and national teacher training. She has worked with the Task Force for International Cooperation on Holocaust and Education Remembrance and Research and facilitated trainings in the attic at Terezin. Noreen is a past member of the Florida Commissioner of Education's Task Force on Holocaust Education, the Association of Holocaust Organizations, as well as a presenter and instructor at numerous international, national and state conferences and organizations. Noreen has a BS in education from the University of Cincinnati, as well as a MS in education from the State University College of New York at Buffalo, and post masters work in reading and writing.

Kelley Szany serves as the Associate Director of Education for the Illinois Holocaust Museum and Education Center. With her guidance, IHMEC's Speakers' Bureau program has developed into the largest cadre of survivor speakers in the United States, with over 60 volunteers. She has become recognized as a leading contemporary genocide educator, speaking to students and teachers not only on the Holocaust but the genocides of Cambodia, Bosnia, Rwanda and Darfur, and enactment of social change. In 2007, she received an Alfred Lerner Fellowship through the Jewish Foundation for the Righteous to study at Columbia University in New York, and in 2008 receive the Samuel Goldsmith Award from the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago. A graduate of Canisius College in New York and Loyola University Chicago, she holds a B.A. in history and M.A. in Public History.

The **Illinois Holocaust Museum & Education Center** is 65,000 square-foot, state-of-the art facility in Skokie, dedicated to preserving the memories of those lost in the Holocaust and to teaching current generations about their role in combating hatred, indifference and genocide in today's world. Likely the last major Holocaust memorial built in collaboration with survivors, IHMEC is the largest center in the Midwest, providing a wide array of educational programming and resources for students and educators.
